Mornings typically begin at Green Park for the guard change finishing at Borough Market for lunch (closed Mons) or a historic pub.

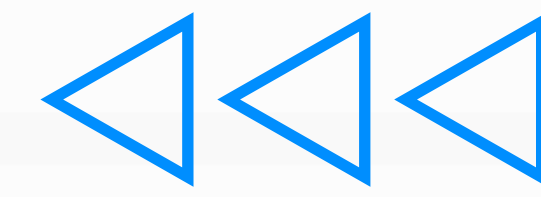

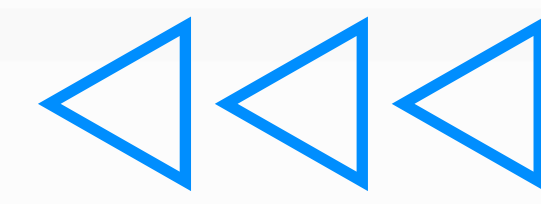

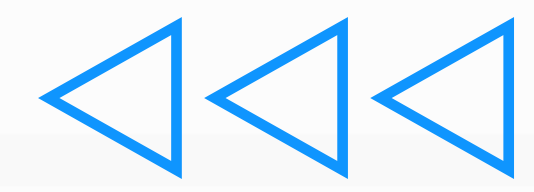

In-person or virtual presenters will have 13 minutes for paper presentation, and then 2 minutes for Q&A.

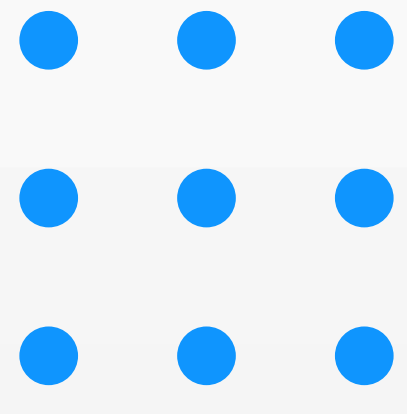
